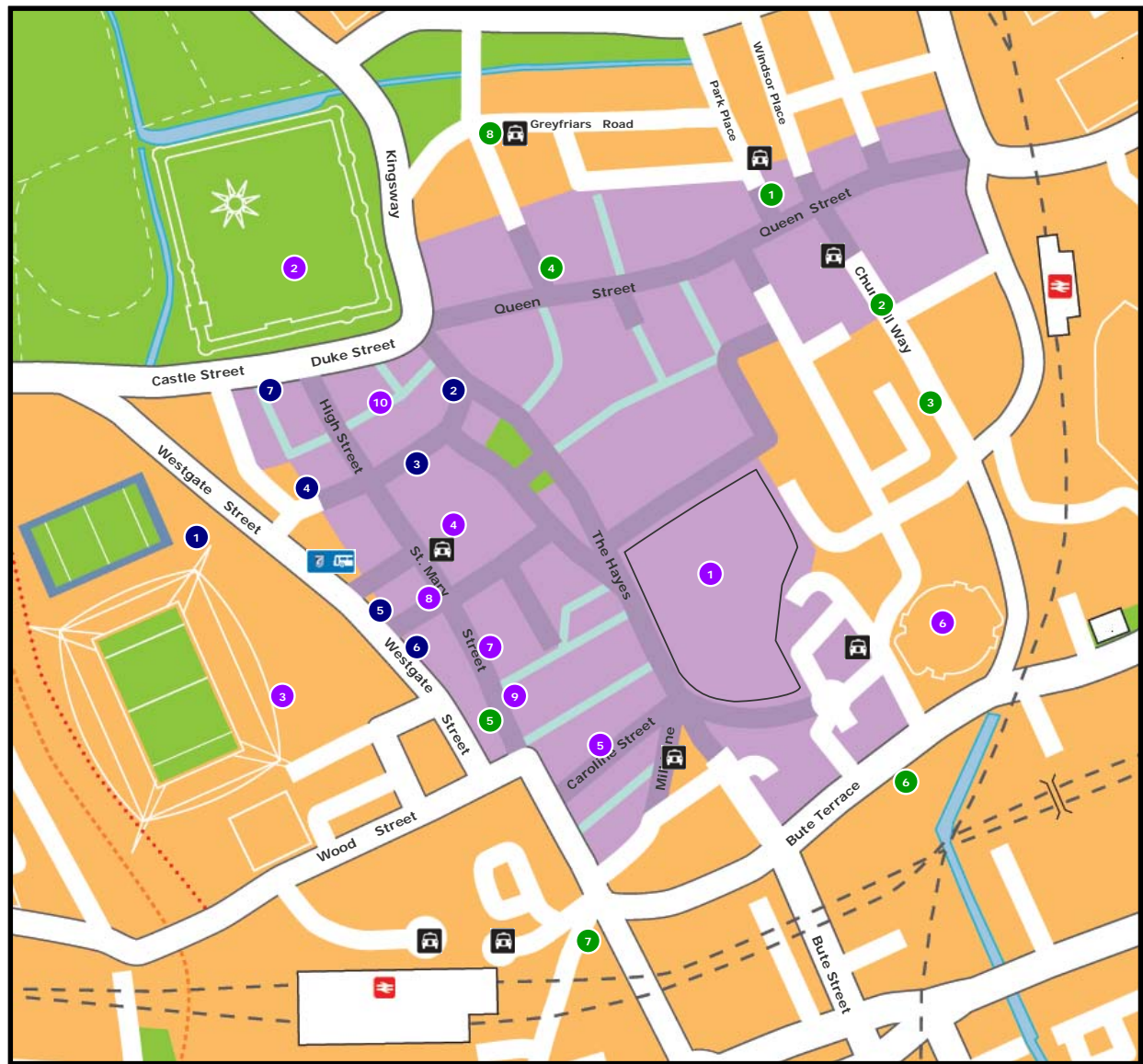
## Away Supporters Information Pack

### Pubs

Drinkers in Cardiff are lucky to be able to choose from hundreds of fine drinking establishments. Wherever you find yourself you are likely to have a great time but here are some of our suggestions.

- 1 **Cardiff Arms Park Clubhouse**  
The home of rugby in Cardiff. The Blues have now moved down the road but the Arms Park is still the home of Welsh Premiership side Cardiff RFC. A fantastic atmosphere on an International day and a clubhouse full of history.
- 2 **The Owain Glyndwr**  
A good pub in the centre of Cardiff. The staff are friendly and are normally happy to put the rugby on if asked. Good beer and cheap food.
- 3 **The Old Arcade**  
The Old Arcade claims to be the most famous rugby pub in the world. Serving good beer and with Sky TV (including 3D), the Old A is a good place for a drink on a match day. Unfortunately, these days you are more likely to find football on the TV on a Saturday afternoon – but just ask and point out the bold claims on the walls and they are likely to switch to rugby!
- 4 **The City Arms**  
Another pub serving good beer in the centre of Cardiff. The City Arms often stays open late so is a great place to head later on in the evening.
- 5 **The Queen's Vaults**  
The closest pub to the stadium bus and the scene of a few of the news stories that Wales players past and present would probably rather we didn't know about.
- 6 **Zero Degrees**  
Micro-brewery and restaurant, serving a wide variety of its own beers (with happy hour until 7pm weekday evenings) and fantastic pizza. A good place for a feed pre/post-match and occasionally sport on the big screen.
- 7 **Dempsey's**  
Good Irish bar in a central location; lots of Blues fans here before matches.
- 8 **Canton RFC**  
A great little rugby club very close to Cardiff City Stadium – a good place to get into the rugby mood on match day.
- 9 **The Ninian Park**  
Very close to Cardiff City Stadium. Once known as a football pub but now under new management; Cardiff Blues Supporters' Club members get 15% off drinks and can often be found here before and after matches.
- 10 **The Sand Martin**  
The closest pub to Cardiff City Stadium. More of a food place but very convenient.

- 1 **Millenium Stadium**  
Welsh National Stadium – Hard to miss really.
- 2 **Caroline Street "Chippy Lane"**  
The place to go in Cardiff for your late night feast.
- 3 **St. Davids Centre**  
Huge new shopping centre – Not sure why you would want to shop on a match day?
- 4 **Cardiff Castle**  
Again hard to miss but definitely worth a view if you fancy some culture.
- 5 **Cardiff Market**  
Cardiff's fantastic covered market.
- 6 **Cardiff Motorpoint Arena**  
Large concert venue in the centre of Cardiff
- 7 **Tesco Metro**
- 8 **Sainsbury Local**
- 9 **Baguette Me Not**  
Fantastic place to go for breakfast (or lunch) Try the 20 piece full welsh breakfast.
- 10 **New York Deli**  
Lovely New-York style sandwich shop located in High Street Arcade. Even better if you like big portions.
- 11 **ASDA**  
Large Supermarket next door to the stadium.
- 12 **McDonalds**
